Support KSISA by Shopping at Kroger

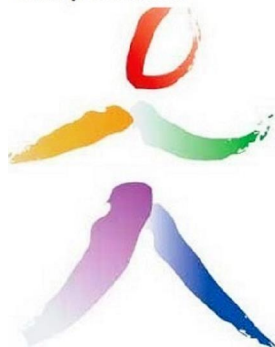
